September 17, 2022 MEETING MINUTES

Introduction of non-member guests and visiting shipmates - There were no visitors

The Blessing of God was invoked by Chaplain Dennis McCully

Meeting was declared convened at 12:15 pm.

The Minutes of the July 2022 Meetings were read and approved.

Standing Committee Reports:

Communications received since the July 2022 Meeting were covered.

The Treasurer's Report for as of 8/31/2022 was given and included a report on the NW Regional Convention.

The convention was hosted by Inland Empire Branch 38. The 50/50 raffle went off well, bringing in \$230 total. It was won by Scott Duenas from the Branch in Guam. The Silent Auction brought in \$1082.50 total. It was proposed and voted on to divide the monies up since all branches attending provided something for the auction. The division was 50% to the NW FRA Region, 25% to the NW LAFRA Region, and 25% to the Hosting Branch. Therefore Branch 38's portion was \$270.62. We were able to refund two shipmates that paid for meals, but were ill or taking care of someone that was disabled. That still left us with a \$470.44 profit for the Convention. Better than we did in 2014.
