MAY 13, 2023 - MEETING MINUTES

2023 Northwest Regional Convention – will be held August 18-19, 2023, at the Holiday Inn in Nampa, ID. It will be sponsored by Gem State Branch 382. Room Rates are \$110 per night plus 8% tax. The rates are good August 15 through August 20, 2023. Phone the hotel directly at (208) 468-0944 and tell them you are with the Fleet Reserve Association block. Deadline for reservations at this rate is July 18, 2023. After that it will be on space availability.

NWR Nominating Resolution

RPNW Rex Faubion is running for another term in 2023-2024. RVPNW Tim Miller is running for another term in 2023-2024 Branch 38 President Robert Bean has expressed interest in running for RVPNW this year. The Branch Secretary was asked to prepare the nominating resolution for him.

The letter has been prepared and signed for his candidacy.

2023 FRA/LAFRA National Convention will be held September 23-30, 2023 at the Nugget Casino Resort, Sparks, Nevada. The room rates are \$102 plus 13.5% tax and a \$2.00 Tourism Fee per night for a single or double. There is a fee of \$10 per person for each additional person, with a limit of four per room. The hotel provides a free shuttle service to and from the Reno/Tahoe Airport. The reservation link for the hotel is posted on the FRA Website if you wish to make reservations that way or you may call either of these numbers: 1-800-648-1177 or 775-356-3300. Be sure to use the code GFRAC23. If you need to make reservations for an ADA (handicap) room you need to call the hotel directly and not use the link. A standard ADA room has a tub/shower with grab bars, but if you need a roll-in shower this will need to be specified also. The rooms with roll-in shower are in the other tower so additional walking will be needed, (but if you are using a scooter it shouldn't be any problem). Remember as with any hotel the number of ADA rooms is limited so please make your reservations early. If you want a room other than the standard king/double queen room you will need to call directly to reserve (do not forget to use the code GFRAC23). The reservation cutoff date is 31August. All rooms have a refrigerator and a Keurig coffee maker. Though Keurig cups are provided, if you drink a lot of coffee or like a special brand it is recommended you bring Keurig coffee cups with you.

Information on tuxedo rentals, scooter, and wheelchair rentals are included in their newsletter #2 which will be on the Branch and Region websites.

FRA National Officers Nominating Resolutions

She has already sent the Branch her request for support and the Branch has voted to support her. Branch President Bean signed her response card we received to send back to the FRA NED. PRPNW Pete Lazzaretti is a candidate for NVP also. Navy Chief's Organization Rep Report – Branch 38 James Grisham, the Navy Chief's Rep has a couple of issues to bring to the FRA's attention.

New Business

Membership Report – Branch 38 membership is maintaining 61 members.

Frank J. McPherson Memorial Award – HQ expects a nominee from each Region to be submitted. "One shipmate who exemplifies the FRA three cardinal principles, Loyalty, Protection, and Service, especially in membership endeavors. The shipmate selected must have expended extensive effort towards the overall growth of the FRA. The selectee does not have to be a top recruiter, but an individual who has maintained a positive public attitude as it affects the membership and retention of members in the Association."

Branch 38 members nominated Shipmate Burke, Branch 38's Secretary/Treasurer for this award. She was asked if she would type up the form and narrative for the Branch BOD's approval.

NW Region 2023 PCT Dues – The annual PCT Dues for the NW Region are due. They are \$21 this year. Authorization was given to pay the dues to the NWR.

FRA Ad in VFW State Convention Booklet – Last year the Branch placed an Ad in their convention booklet and they are asking us again if we want to do it again this year. Cost would be \$75 for a ¹/₂ page color ad.

A discussion was held, and the Branch voted to sponsor a ¹/₄ page add that cost \$35. The Branch Secretary/Treasurer was directed to send in the necessary information to make it happen.
