### **2024 NW Regional Convention**

The 2024 Northwest Regional Convention will be held on September 6-7, 2024, at the Clover Island Inn located in Kennewick, Washington. It is being held later than normal since the 2024 National Convention won't be held until November to coincide with the FRA 100-year Celebration.

Shipmate Rick Baldwin will be the Chair of the Branch Delegates for the upcoming convention in September 2024.

Inland Empire Branch 38, Spokane, WA will be coordinating with all the Northwest Branches to contribute their ideas into this convention. Our idea is to make this a "true" northwest regional convention by having each Branch in the Northwest Region take responsibility for one of the activities that happen during a convention.

Room Rates are \$114 per night plus 10.7% tax and \$3 Tourist Fee. These rates are good for September 4 to September 8, 2024. Reservations made after August 26, 2024, at this rate will be on space availability.

The convention itself will be held at the DoubleTree by Hilton, 210 Holiday Court, Annapolis, Maryland, on November 10-16, 2024. The Centennial will be on November 11, 2024, and the Convention itself will be held November 12-25, 2024. Information is now available on the FRA Website.

Robert Bean, Jr Past Branch President will be the branch delegate to the 2024 FRA Centennial and National Convention since he is already scheduled to go as the Northwest Regional Vice President. He is running for Regional President also. His nominating resolution will be ready to sign by the April Branch Meeting.
